

Questions on Pentecost to think about (Acts 1 and 2)

EITHER

Do a discovery bible study on Acts 2 :-

1. Read the passage once (1 or 2 people only)
2. Re-tell it in your own words from memory. (1 or 2 people only with others chipping in)
3. Ask the following questions (without referring to anything outside the passage!) :-
 - a. What does this passage tell us about God, Jesus or his plan?
 - b. What does this passage tell us about humans?
 - c. If this passage is true, then what do you need to do?
 - d. According to this study,
 - i. What am I doing well?
 - ii. What do I need to change?
 - e. Who else needs to hear this story?
 - i. How might I tell them?

OR

Dig a bit deeper:-

1. **Some Biblical Echoes.** Look at Exodus 19:14-19 and Daniel 7: 9-14, Jer 31:31-34
 - a. Why would Pentecost have reminded the disciples and the Jews of these scriptures?
 - b. What might they have concluded about Jesus from his ascension and the Pentecost day event as these came to mind?
